ENTRIES

1. **All entries for Class 1 must be age validated by the Branch DC**
2. **All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee of £1**
3. **As this is an Area competition, you must have been selected by your DC to enter**
4. If you need to cancel an entry, change details or any other queries before the closing date, please email lindsaybryars@icloud.com
5. Late entries will only be accepted providing there is space.
6. Substitutions may only be made in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2023. Please email your changes to lindsaybryars@icloud.com

RULES

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2023
2. In the event of abandonment, 25% of each individual entry fee will be retained to defray expenses.
3. **Refunds:**
 - i. **100% up to 11am on Friday 30th June 2023**
 - ii. **No refunds after 11am on Friday 30th June 2023**
4. Dogs must be kept on short leads **at all times**
5. The Judges' decision is final. In the event of a dispute or objection arising, **an objection in writing together with £50 must be lodged with the Secretary by the Branch representative within 30 minutes of the incident.** Any appeal will be heard by the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury will be final.
6. Hats must be tagged with a PINK tag and body protectors must be to BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).
7. Three competitor numbers must be printed on A4 by competitors and brought to the competition. No printed numbers will be provided by the Organisers. Print templates will be available at www.ponyclubresults.co.uk. **Please display one number in the front window of your vehicle.**
8. Courses will be open for walking on Saturday 8th July from 2pm. **NO CARS ON XC COURSE, PLEASE PARK AT THE QUEEN'S BUILDING & WALK DOWN TO THE COURSE**
9. Please obey parking stewards at all times. PC teams will be parked together.
10. Please pick up all poo, hay & litter from around your trailer/lorry

11. All competitors must travel with equine passports and comply with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule in the Eventing Rule Book 2023. District Commissioners must validate compliance at the time of entry.
12. Photographic Rights – unless stated competitors and their parents/guardians are deemed to have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
13. The Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend any aspect of the competition.

HEALTH AND SAFETY Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present.
