All classes will have limited spaces.

Ring 1- 9:00am am start

Class 1 First Rally Pony – lead rein

Rosettes for all.

Class 2 First Rally Pony – assisted 13hh & under
Riders 10 yrs & under. First rally ponies may be ridden in any
suitable bridle. Rosettes for all.

Class 3 First ridden – must be unassisted no jumping
involved.

Class 4 Pony Club Pony & Rider 14:2hh & under
Riders 12 years & under. To be judged 50% on pony, 50% on
rider. A small amount of jumping will be required. Classes
may be divided.
Rosettes for all.

Ring 1 – 1:30pm approx.

Class 5 Fancy Dress.

Correct head gear must be worn.

Gymkhana Games – 2:30pm Approx

No whips allowed. Rosettes for all.

a) **Small & steady** – 6 years & under May be assisted or led
(if unable to ride off lead rein)

More experienced 5 or 6 yr olds should enter 9 years and
under section.

b) 9 years & under – May be assisted or led (if unable to be
off lead rein)

c) 10-12 years No cantering. Assistants & leaders may not
be in front of ponies' heads please. The children's safety and
enjoyment must be the priority here. Each section will do the
following races.

a) Walk and Trot

b) Bending

c) Mug race

d) Ride and Run

Ring 3 - 9:45am Start

Class 6 40 cm (1'3") Jumping – to be judged on style & manner of jumping

Section A) Riders may be led or assisted Riders 10 years & under

Section B) Unassisted

Class 7 50 cm (1'6") Jumping – to be judged on style & manner of jumping

Section A) Riders may be assisted or led

Section B) unassisted

Class 8 60cm (1'11") Jumping

Section A) Novice – combination of pony & rider not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any showjumping competition at this height or above.

Section B) Open

Class 9 Open Jumping 70cm (2'3")

Class 10 Pairs Jumping 70cm (2'3") Entry fee £10 per pair

Class 11 Open Jumping 75cm (2'6")

Classes 6,7,8,9 and 11 will be 2 phase, a jump off to follow on from 1st round (class 6 and 7 not timed, classes 8,9 and 11 to be timed).

Class 10 each competitor will jump one timed round.

Ring 4 – Clear Round Jumping starting at 8:45am £3 per round £5 for 2 rounds. Running until 12 noon when there will be Class 12. It may continue after this if there is demand

Class 12 – Horse and Hound – approx. 2' horse and rider jump one round then rider dismounts and leads their dog over the same jumps. Judged on style.

Ring 5 – Handy Pony starting at 10am £3 per round £5 for 2 rounds. Children and ponies to complete a number of obstacles. Section a) assisted or led b) unassisted. Rosettes to all.

Legal Liability: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Health and Safety : The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards

RULES OF THE SHOW

The Show will run under Pony Club Rules 2023

1. The decision of the Judges is final in all cases.
2. Correct riding dress including Pony Club approved and tagged headgear must be worn at all times when mounted.
Hats to be tagged by competitors own Pony Club branch
3. No entry fees will be refunded without a Doctor's or Vet's Certificate.
4. ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A SHORT LEAD.
5. All competitors to be 12 years old or under on 1st January 2023 and ponies to be 14.2hh or under.
6. The organisers reserve the right to divide or amalgamate classes according to the level of entries, or alter the schedule as necessary.
7. No outside assistance will be permitted except where stated.
8. No mucking out of trailers and boxes onto the field, please.
9. A pony may only enter each class once.
10. Ponies to be 4 years or over. No stallions permitted at the show.
11. No spurs to be worn. No jewellery, including earrings to be worn.
12. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less £5 per competitor, to cover administration costs.
13. There will be no cantering outside the rings & practice area.
14. Competitors should enter classes suitable for their ability & experience.
15. No pony over 14.2hh or rider over 12 years may ride on the showground during the event.
16. Up to date FLUVAC required
17. Back protectors recommended for jumping classes but not compulsory

Directions to the show:

Directions to Middle Wyke House, Andover SP11 6AJ

From A34 & A303 direction

From A303 (through Andover)

Take exit to A3093 signed Walworth Industrial Estate

At 1st roundabout follow Town Centre / Ring Road / Walworth Industrial Estate

At 2nd roundabout take 1st exit (pass Twining's building on the right)

At 3rd roundabout take 2nd exit, follow Superstore / Town centre.

Road goes down hill.

At 4th roundabout (in town – large Tesco on the right)

Take right lane, then take 3rd exit to Newbury A343.

See "Pets at Home" on the left.

Go under Railway Bridge.

At 5th roundabout turn right (2nd exit) to St Mary Bourne / Smannell (RAPC sign)

Pass houses on right. Playing fields on left.

Then over mini roundabout, through traffic lights.

New housing on left. Through estate then follow signs for Finkley (RAPC sign)

Pass village sign of Finkley, continue for approx 2 miles.

Middle Wyke House is on the right.

DO NOT APPROACH FROM ST MARY BOURNE VILLAGE
