WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

- Class 1 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER PONY – jumps not exceeding 95 cms
Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 153 cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before January 1st in the current year.
- Class 2 WORKING HUNTER PONY – jumps not exceeding 85 cms
Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153 cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before January 1st in the current year.
- Class 3 WORKING HUNTER PONY – jumps not exceeding 75 cms
Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 143 cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before January 1st in the current year.
- Class 4 WORKING HUNTER PONY – jumps not exceeding 65 cms
Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 133 cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before January 1st in the current year.

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 to 4

RING 1 – to follow WHP

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

- Class 5 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER – jumps not exceeding 75 cms
Open to horses 4 years old and over, 15 hh (153 cm) and over.
Not to have won a novice class prior to 1st January 2020.
- Class 6 OPEN WORKING HUNTER – Course approximately 105cms.
Open to horses 4 years old and over, 15 hh (153 cm) and over.

- Class 8 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY – jumps not exceeding 65 cms
5 years old & over, not exceeding 143 cms.
- Class 9 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY – jumps not exceeding 55 cms
5 years old & over, not exceeding 133 cms.

COLOURED CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 13 & 14

VETERANS

(to follow Coloureds)

- Class 15 VETERAN HORSE OR PONY 15 YEARS AND OVER TO BE SHOWN IN HAND
- Class 16 VETERAN HORSE OR PONY 15 YEARS AND OVER TO BE SHOWN UNDER SADDLE

VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 15 & 16

RING 3 – not before 12 noon

- Class 17 LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND ANY AGE IN HAND
- Class 18 SMALL MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND ANY AGE IN HAND
- Class 19 LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FOUR YEARS OLD AND OVER UNDER

attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
Class will be marked out of 100 as follows:

Rider's position 25
Overall impression 25
- Class 22 PONY EQUITATION – ponies not exceeding 148 cms. Riders not to have
attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
Class will be marked out of 100 as follows:
Rider's use of seat and aids 50
Rider's position 25
Overall impression 25
- Class 23 PONIES not exceeding 128 cms. On leading rein – riders not to have attained
their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 21 to 23

RING 4 – 8.00 am

HUNTERS UNDER SADDLE

Class 24 FOUR OR FIVE YEAR OLD MARE OR GELDING – 15 hh (153 cm) and over.

Class 25 RIDDEN COB – 4 years old and over, 14.2 hh (148 cm) and over.

Class 26 RIDDEN HUNTER – for horses 15 hh (153 cm) and over.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 24 to 26
Champion & Reserve eligible for the Overall Hunter Championship

RING 4 – not before 12 noon

RETRAINING OF RACEHORSES

Class 27 EX RACEHORSE IN HAND – open to any ex racehorse 3 years and over, fillies, mares and geldings.
Blemishes causes through racing will be ignored.

Class 28 EX RACEHORSE RIDDEN – open to any ex racehorse 4 years and over. Horse should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle.
Blemishes causes through racing will be ignored.
The judge will not ride.

EX RACEHORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 27 & 28

RING 5 – 10.00 am

SHOW JUMPING

- Class 29 BEGINNERS
Maximum height of jumps 60 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
- Class 30 NURSERY
Maximum height of jumps 70 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
- Class 31 NOVICE
Maximum height of jumps 80 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
- Class 32 INTERMEDIATE
Maximum height of jumps 90 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.
- Class 33 OPEN
Maximum height of jumps 100 cms. Open to all ages of Horse/Pony and rider.

DRESSAGE – 8.30 am

- Class 34 Intro C - Restricted to riders who have never been placed 1st to 3rd at Prelim level.
- Class 35 Prelim 7 - Restricted to riders who have not won more than twice at prelim level.
- Class 36 Prelim 12 - Open
- Class 37 Novice 27 - Open
